Hair clogs are common in bathroom drains. If you find yourself standing ankle deep in water while showering, or waiting at the sink for water to go down the drain, it's likely you have a hair clog. Chemical drain cleaners are often only partially effective and leave hair in the drain. **The Drain Millipede** contains over 4,000 hooks that snag and remove hair clogs on contact.



1) Uncoil and straighten snake below the handle and sleeve as shown.



2) Insert snake into sink, shower or tub drain opening. The Drain Millipede will slide past most drain pop-up stoppers and grates.



3) Place one hand on the sleeve. Using the other hand, rotate handle 360 degrees several times to entangle hair and debris.



4) Pull out snake and debris from drain. Repeat steps 2, 3, and 4 as needed while re-inserting to different depths within the drain. To reuse: Remove hair and clean using an old toothbrush.
